Tech filing asking for dismissal has no basis of merit itself

Team Leach supporters of former Texas Tech coach Mike Leach asks how the University's attorneys can make a filing for individuals and use testimony from a doctor they hired to testify as the entire basis for their claim

Team Leach also believes that the University's full-court press to get out its news release from this afternoon's news conference shows that the school knows it's losing in the battle of public opinion. Why else would it, for the first time, get the Alumni Association to use its mailing list to put out a press release? That's assuming a letter sent on behalf of members of the Board of Regents is not considered a press release.

Team Leach believes that this move by the Tech administration is an act of desperation. A review of depositions that have been released so far overwhelmingly shows that Coach Leach was wrongly terminated by Texas Tech University. We anticipate the opportunity for Coach Leach to prove that belief before a jury.

The arrogance of the Tech Administration and its lawyer shown after the firing of Coach Leach is another issue that we hope will be addressed by the University, Students, Graduates and hopefully the Governor after the legal proceedings are over.
